LOCATION:

- State Capitol Building 500 E. Capitol, Pierre, SD 57501
- When making your travel plans, please take into consideration that legislative session is in process and there surely will be limited parking, so be sure to allow enough time to find a parking spot.
- Enter through the north door (the rear side of the building that faces Broadway Ave.)
 - Proceed straight ahead until you get to the stairway and go down the stairs.
 You'll see a sign with DDN on the railing facing you. Proceed downstairs.
 - Once you get downstairs, walk straight ahead and turn right and continue down the hall.
 - The main door for the DDN rooms will be on your right hand side of the hallway and marked as DDN.
